
By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Ogier & Boxalls, 3rd Floor, Queensgate House, South Church Street, P.O. Box 1234 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendants:

- (1) an order that the transfer of Parcel 63H20 of Block 15D of the South Sound Registration Section of Grand Cayman from the First Defendant solely to the First and Second Defendants as Joint Proprietors on the 24th day of February 2005 be set aside;

- (2) an order that the Register for Parcel 63H20 of Block 15D of the South Sound Registration Section of Grand Cayman be rectified and the First Defendant be re-registered as the sole proprietor; and
- (3) an order inhibiting the registration of any dealing with Parcel 63H20 of Block 15D of the South Sound Registration Section of Grand Cayman until further order of the Grand Court.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.
