

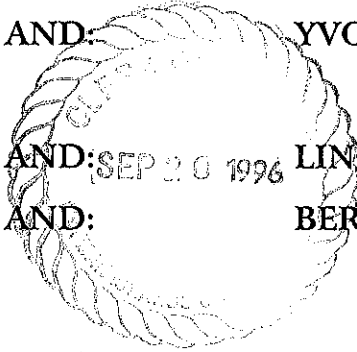

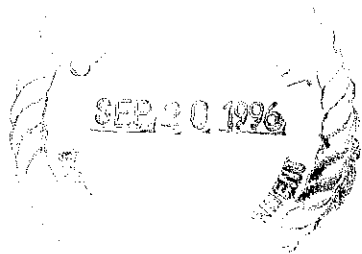
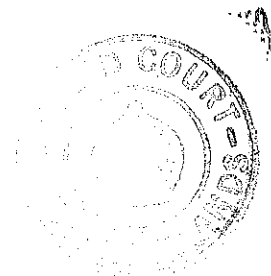

the Administration thereof.

2. That upon proof and satisfaction to this Honourable Court that there has been a true and proper administration of the Estate the assets now forming part of the Estate of JACQUES PETERSON KELLY, Deceased be transferred to and paid to the Plaintiffs and all other persons entitled thereto under the Will of JACQUES PETERSON KELLY, Deceased.
3. Further and/or in the alternative and Order that the said LYNARD KELLY and BERKLEY LINDO KELLY be relieved as Executors and Trustees of the said Estate and replaced by the Plaintiffs and that all vesting and other orders in respect of the Estate assets and Trust be made.
4. That this Honourable Court does make such further and/or other directions as it deems fit.
5. That the Plaintiffs be awarded the costs of this application by the Estate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 14 days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office.

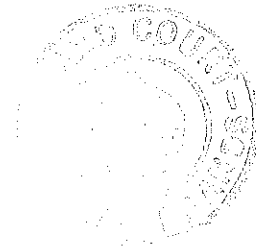
