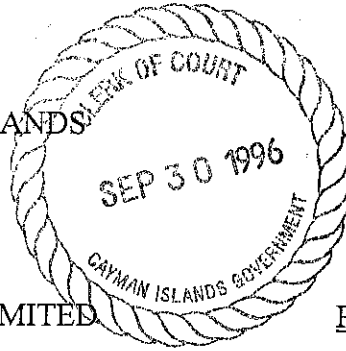

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

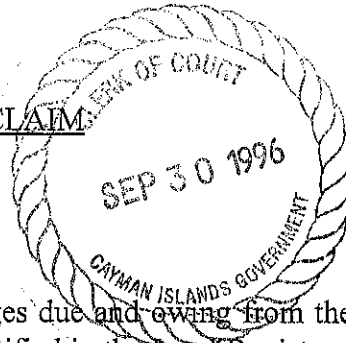

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

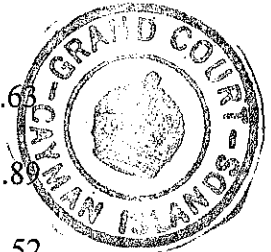


The Plaintiff's claim is for:-

(1) the sum of CI\$6,381.52, being electricity charges due and owing from the Defendant to the Plaintiff in respect of that part of the premises, identified in the Land Register as Registration Section West Bay Beach South, Block 12E, Parcel 5, known as Santiago's Restaurant and Cantina, occupied by the Defendant.

Particulars

15th April - 15th May 1996	CI\$1,662.68
15th July - 15th September 1996	CI\$4,718.89
Total:	CI\$6,381.52



(2) the sum of CI\$5,667, being remuneration due and owing from the Defendant to the Plaintiff in respect of the Defendant's use and occupation of the said premises during the month of September 1996;

(3) an injunction, to restrain the Defendant, until the trial of this action or further order of the Court, from removing out of the jurisdiction any of the contents of the said premises belonging to the Defendant and used by it in the course of its business;

(4) interest on the aforesaid sums of CI\$6,318.52 and CI\$5,667 pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the rate of 8.375% per annum from the date of issue hereof to judgment or soon payment;

(5) costs.

If, within the time limited for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$12,548.52 (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorneys.
