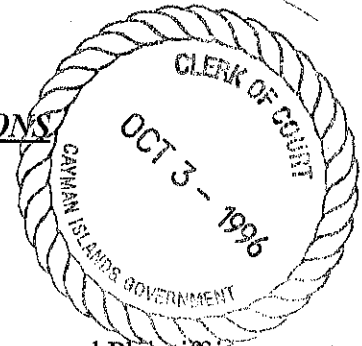

***If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.***

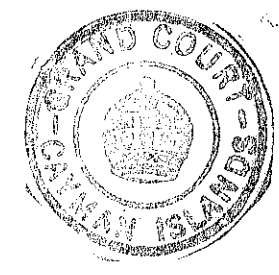
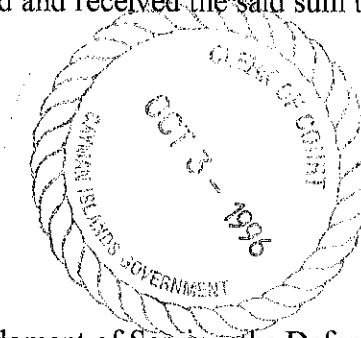

10. That on or about the 9th day of September 1996 the said N.C.B. (Cayman) Ltd. carried out the aforesaid mandate of the Plaintiff.
11. That on or about the 10th day of September 1996 the Plaintiff was informed by the said N.C.B (Cayman) Ltd. that the Barnett Bank of South Florida, N.A. cheque TE1411678 had been dishonored by the said Barnett Bank of South Florida, N.A. on the basis that the said cheque was a counterfeit and demanded an immediate return of the moneys disbursed as aforesaid as per the mandate given to it by the Plaintiff in consequence of the instructions of the Defendant.
12. That since on or about the said 10th day of September 1996 the Plaintiff has made persistent demands on the Defendant to return the said disbursed sums to the Plaintiff in order for the Plaintiff to make good its account with the said N.C.B.(Cayman) Ltd.

3. Costs.



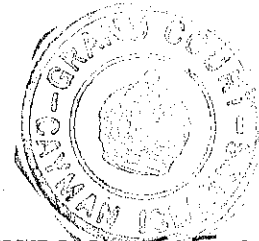
