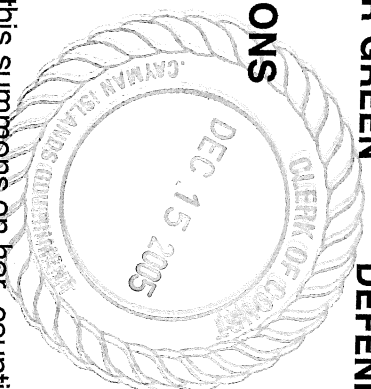

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of **Darren Dale Kirchman**, of P.O. Box 61 East End, the Plaintiff seeks the following Orders that:

1. He may be granted sole custody of the minor child **ISAIAH ALEXANDER GREEN** pursuant to the Guardianship and Custody of Children Law.
2. That the Defendant be restrained whether by herself, her servants and/ or agents or otherwise, from removing or attempting to remove **ISAIAH ALEXANDER GREEN** from the care and custody of the Plaintiff, or from the jurisdiction, without the express consent of the Plaintiff.
3. That the Defendant be allowed reasonable and defined access to the minor child.
4. That the Defendant do pay to the Plaintiff, the sum of CI \$ 50 per week for the maintenance of the said child.
5. That the Defendant do pay the costs of this application.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgement may be given or order made against or in relation to her as the Court may think just and expedient.
