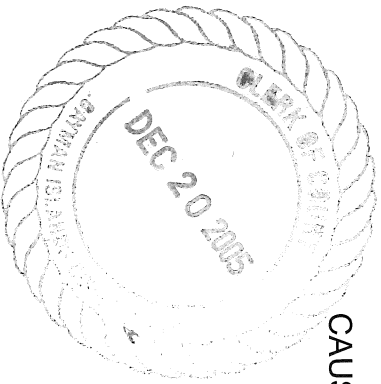

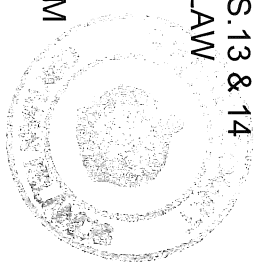

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of *January* 2005 at *9:30* o'clock in the *2:00 PM* noon on the hearing of an application by the Applicants, who seek the determination of the Court on the following question, namely an Order

1. That the Applicants be appointed guardians of the said Thomas Paterson Adam ('the patient') and over his estate and effects with the following powers conferred upon them
 - (a) To control and manage any property of the patient;
 - (b) To sell, acquire, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the patient;

- (c) To invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the patient in such securities as the Applicants for the time being are authorised by law to invest trust funds.
 - (d) to deposit in to and withdraw from any account at any bank or lending institution in the Cayman Islands and elsewhere such of the patient's monies as may e necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the patient.
2. That the Applicants shall keep proper accounts of the administration and management of the property of the patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such accounts.
 3. That the cost of this application and the cost of the guardians incidental to and consequent upon the Order shall be paid form the estate and property of the patient.
