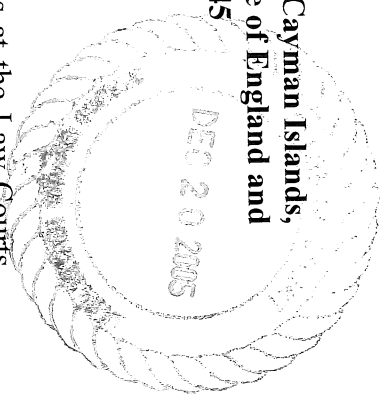

The Applicants may be given directions permitting them to disclose confidential information, namely information relating to The Dolphin Trust and The Mana Trust (together "the Trusts"), Kaffee Limited, Barla Finance Limited, Cunur Cash Limited, Medro Limited (together "the Companies") and Yahya Murat Demirel, in evidence pursuant to an Order of the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands in Cause No. 555 of 2005 and Orders of the High Court of Justice of England and Wales, Chancery Division in Claim No. HC05C03744 and Claim No. HC05C03745 (together "the Orders").

Particulars identifying the said confidential information required to be given in response to the Orders will be set out in an affidavit intended to be sworn in these proceedings. As

required by the Orders and by such means as this Court directs, the Applicants intend to give in evidence confidential information in relation to which the Applicants, the Trusts and the Companies, and any person with a beneficial entitlement thereto, may have an interest.

2. Such directions as to service of Notice of the Summons herein as the Court shall think fit.
3. Such further or other directions and orders as the Court shall think fit.
