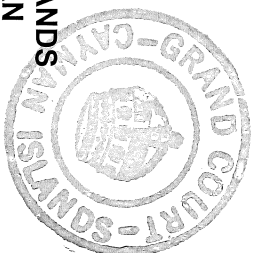

ORIGINATING SUMMONS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A GUARDIAN

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law
Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the 26th day of Jan 2006 at 9³⁰ o'clock, on
the hearing of an application by the Applicant for the appointment of a Legal Guardian for
Mrs. Lilly Tibbetts of Cayman Brac, Cayman Islands.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Sandra Mitchell, of Bedford,
Kentucky, USA the Applicant seeks an Order in respect of Lilly Tibbetts pursuant to s. 13 of
The Mental Health Law, (1997 Revision), s.14 of The Grand Court Law (1995 Revision)
and Order 80, rr. 17, 28 and 29 of the Grand Court Rules, (1995 Revision).


The Applicant seeks an Order:

1. That a Guardian and Receiver be appointed for the said Lilly Tibbetts ("the Patient") and over her person, property and effects, with immediate effect.
2. That Sandra Mitchell be appointed as such Guardian and Receiver with full power to manage the Patient, the Patient's property and the effects of the Patient with the following express powers, namely, power to :
 - a. authorize any medical or surgical treatment/operation upon the Patient, which in the considered opinion of a medical practitioner is necessary for the Patient to undergo.
 - b. control and manage the Patient's finances and property;



- c. sell, exchange charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the Patient;
- d. acquire any property in the name of the Patient;
- e. provide for the management of a business;
- f. reimburse out of the Patient's property with or without interest any money applied by any person either in payment of the Patient's debts or for the maintenance or benefit of the Patient;
- g. complete a contract; and
- h. conduct legal proceedings on behalf of the Patient.
