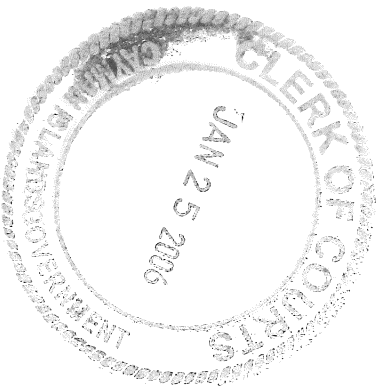

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Rodney Hansen of [address], the Plaintiff seeks the determination of the Court on the following questions, namely:

1. That the first Defendant having authorized his attorneys, the Second Defendant, to settle the proceedings between the respective parties upon terms communicated both orally between Mr. Shaun McCann and Mr. Peter Broadhurst, and evidenced in writing in the Second Defendant's letter to the Plaintiff's attorneys dated 16th December 2005, and upon the First Defendant's said offer being accepted orally and then confirmed in writing on 29th December 2005 and again on 5th January 2006, the Plaintiff seeks a Declaration that Cause No. 161 of 2005 is settled.

2. Alternatively, if the Second Defendant made the offer referred to in paragraph 1 above, without the First Defendant's authorization or instructions, the Plaintiff accepted their offer orally and then confirmed in writing on 29th December 2005 and again on 5th January 2006, and the Plaintiff seeks a Declaration that Cause No. 161 of 2005 is settled and that the Second Defendant is liable to pay the settlement sum.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him or them as the Court thinks just and expedient.
