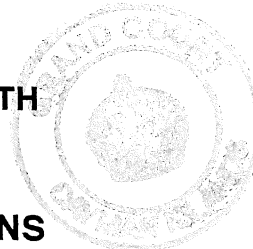

LET THE DEFENDANT of George Town, Grand Cayman, attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the *12th* day of *April* 2006, at *9:30* o'clock in the fore/afternoon, on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of # 42 Canal Lane, George Town, Grand Cayman for Orders :-

1. That the Defendant do make an Affidavit stating whether any of the following documents are or have at any time been in its possession, custody or power, that is, all medical records, medical entry card, nursing and surgical records, medical notes, laboratory reports and any other clinical correspondence regarding its treatment of Thelbert Thaddeus Vidal on 11th February 2004.
2. That the Defendant produce to the Plaintiff and for her inspection, any and all of the above documents within seven (7) days.
3. That if the Defendant is unable to produce any or all of the above documents that were previously in its possession, custody or power, to state what has become of them.
4. That the Defendant pays the costs of this application, to be taxed if not agreed.
5. Any further or other relief.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Summons on it, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service Form to the Courts Office.
