THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the Statement of Claim.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

ISSUED this 11th day of October 1996.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

INDORSEMENT OF CLAIM

The 1st and 2nd Plaintiffs' claim is for:-

- (1) A declaration that the Defendant is not entitled to enter or remain on the 1st Plaintiff's land and building thereon registered as South Sound Block 21B Parcels 6 and 16.
- (2) Damages for trespass thereon and nuisance.
- (3) Damages for trespass to goods therein belonging to the 2nd Plaintiff.
- (4) Aggravated damages.
- (5) An Injunction to restrain the Defendant whether by herself servants, agents or otherwise howsoever from:
 - (a) entering upon the 1st Plaintiff's said land and building;
 - (b) harassing or otherwise interfering with the 1st and/or 2nd Plaintiff in its/their ownership and possession of the said property and/or harassing and/or interfering with the 2nd Plaintiff at his home and/or workplace or in the conduct of his business in these Islands or otherwise.
- (6) Costs.
