

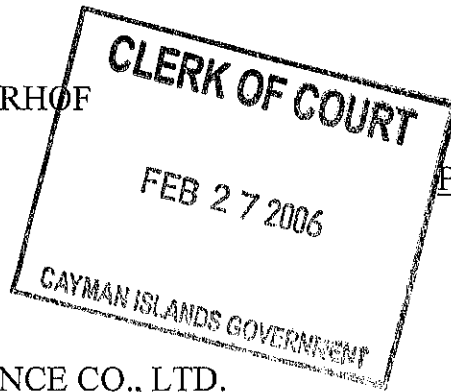

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT of P.O. Box 309 GT, Uglan House, South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the 28th day of March, 2006, at 9:30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of P.O. Box 1234 GT, Queensgate House, Third Floor, South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, that:

1. The Defendant be ordered to supply the Plaintiff with its Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association upon payment by the Plaintiff to the Defendant of the appropriate fee, pursuant to section 29 of the Companies Law (2004 Revision);
2. The Defendant be ordered to supply the Plaintiff with its Register of Members upon payment by the Plaintiff to the Defendant of the appropriate fee, pursuant to section 44 of the Companies Law (2004 Revision);
3. The Defendant be ordered to supply the Plaintiff with its Register of Mortgages and Charges upon payment by the Plaintiff to the Defendant of the appropriate fee, pursuant to section 54 of the Companies Law (2004 Revision);

4. The Defendant to pay the Plaintiff's costs and fees of this Application, to be assessed by the Court

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF
SERVICE OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the Originating Summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the Acknowledgment of Service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Originating Summons*)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of _____" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as _____" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
