

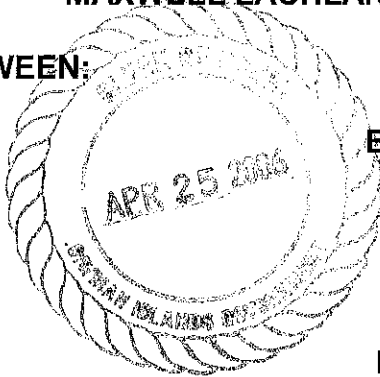

LET THE RESPONDENT of George Town, Grand Cayman attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 16th day of May 2006 at 9³⁰ o'clock in the noon on the hearing of an application by the Applicant, **BARRY WILLIAM BUSH** of West Bay, Grand Cayman for the following Orders:

1. A declaration that the Applicant is the biological father of the minor child **MAXWELL LACHLAN MAYUGA** who was born on the 7th August 2002.
2. That the Applicant be granted joint custody of the minor child, **MAXWELL LACHLAN MAYUGA** with day to day care and control remaining with the

Respondent with reasonable access to be afforded to the Applicant on such terms as this Honourable Court deems fit.

3. That the said child not be removed from the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court without the written consent of the Applicant or further Order of this Court.
3. That there be such further Orders including Orders relating to the maintenance and upkeep of the said child in such terms as this Court deems just and equitable in the circumstances.

LET THE RESPONDENT within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's Office.
