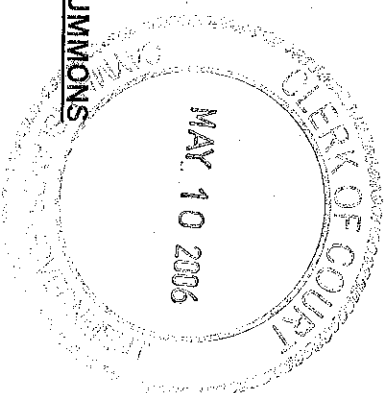

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANTS attend before the Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of May 2006 at am/pm on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following orders:

1. **THAT** this Honourable Court do sanction and permit the sale by private treaty of all that land and property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Register and known particularly as:-
 - (i) Land situate and registered as Registration Section Cayman Brac West, Block 95B, Parcel 117 ("Property A"); and
 - (ii) Land situate and registered as Registration Section Cayman Brac West, Block 111E, Parcel 68 ("Property B").
Properties (A) and (B) collectively ("the Property").
2. **THAT** the Defendants, and, upon service of this Order upon such person, any other person(s) occupying the Property, do within 28 days of the service of this Order, vacate the Property and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the Property.
3. **THAT** this Honourable Court sanction and permit interior inspection by a designated Chartered Quantity Surveyor for obtaining evidence of the value of the Property.

4. **THAT** the Defendants and, upon service of this Order upon such person, any other person(s) occupying the Property do within 28 days of the service of this Order, permit and take all reasonable steps to assist the inspection of the designated Chartered Quantity Surveyor for obtaining evidence of the value of the Property.
5. **THAT** this Honourable Court give directions with regard to the price for the sale of the Property upon receipt of the Valuation Report of the Chartered Quantity Surveyor.
6. **THAT** the Defendants do pay the costs of and incidental to this application.
7. **SUCH** further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.
8. **AND** for an order that the costs of and incidental to this Application be paid by the Defendants/Judgment Debtors.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds of this application are as set out in the affidavit filed in support of this application.
