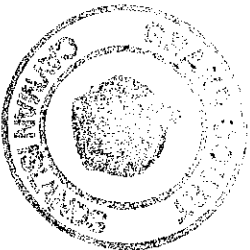

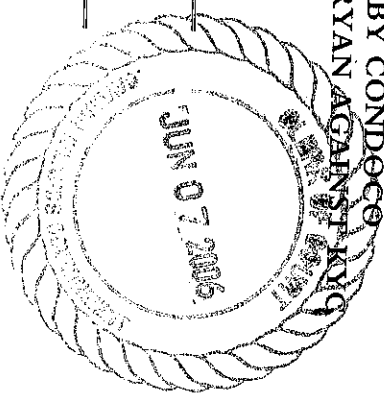


EX PARTE ORIGINATING
