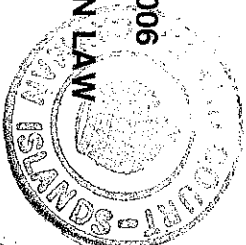
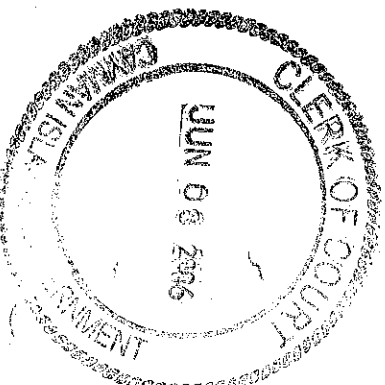
LET THE DEFENDANT SARA CARMEN RAMIREZ of George Town, Grand
