

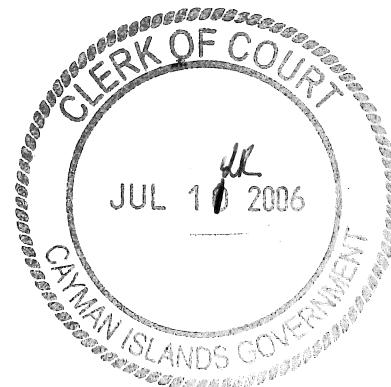
ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, GeorgeTown, Grand Cayman on the day of 2006 at o'clock in the forenoon upon the application by the Attorney General for the following orders that;

1. Richard Clarke; former police officer of the Metropolitan Police Service, United Kingdom, who is currently employed by the Royal Cayman Islands Police appear before the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands for a deposition (in accordance with *Schedule A*) to be sworn to by him in the presence of a Judge of the Grand Court.
2. The deposition is accompanied by a "jurat" and "exhibit page" as attached in *Schedules B & C*.
3. The Clerk of the Courts be directed to affix the seal of the Grand Court as evidence of certification of the documents and return same as a matter of urgency to:

“Deposition of Richard Clarke”

RICHARD CLARKE makes oath and states as follows:-

I am a police officer employed by the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service and attached to the George Town Police Station. On Wednesday 26 April 2006 my attention was drawn to a male, Mr. Delroy Washington Lynch by Detective Sergeant Paul Armstrong. I know Lynch and he first came to my attention whilst executing my operational duties as a uniformed officer at Brixton Police State with the Metropolitan Police Service. I spoke to him on a number of occasions around Coldharbour Lane, London, SW9, during my tenure at Brixton.

I have been sent a certified copy of fingerprint form having the impression of Mr. Delroy Lynch taken by me on 25 January 1994. I can confirm that the completion of the fingerprints form and detail identifying me are correct. My shoulder number whilst working at Brixton Police Station between 1989 to 1994 was "LD102" which corresponds with the rank and number completed on the form.

I produce the certified copy of the fingerprints as exhibit 1.
