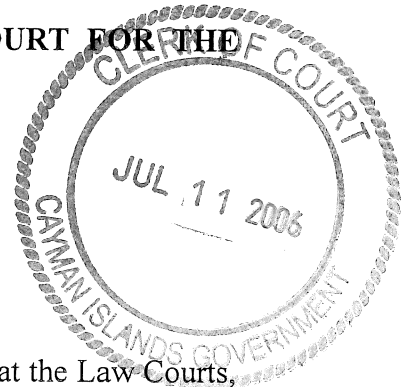


IN THE GRAND COURT OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the        day of        2006 at        o'clock in the forenoon upon an application by the Attorney General for the following orders that;

1. A legal representative or attorney of Brancross (Cayman) Limited, c/o International Corporation Services Limited, P.O. Box 472GT, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands be summoned to attend upon the Courts to be examined by the Clerk of the Courts concerning property held by Brancross (Cayman) Limited but owned by the Defendants, Petro Kiritchenko and Pavlo Lazarenko.
2. The Grand Court of the Cayman Islands is requested to propound to the legal representative or attorney of Brancross (Cayman) Limited the list of questions set out in Schedule A, with presentation of documents when applicable, appended hereto.
3. The Clerk of the Courts shall propound these questions to the legal representative or attorney of Brancross (Cayman) Limited, under oath or affirmation, as to their knowledge of the questions asked. The answers are to be recorded and certified by

the Courts as being answered by the witness. In addition the legal representative or attorney of Brancross (Cayman) Limited is to provide documents which were presented or referred in respect of the questions, answers and/or referred to in Schedule A.

4. The Clerk of the Courts be directed to return to the Office of the Clerk, United States District Court, District of Northern California, 450 Golden Gate Ave., Clerk's Office, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, San Francisco, CA 94102, USA the following:
  - a) The certified document evidencing the deposition/statement and/or answers to questions in Schedule A by the attorney or legal representative of Brancross (Cayman) Limited;
  - b) Certified copies of any documents which were presented or referred to in Schedule A.
  
5. Such other orders and directions as the court deems fit.
