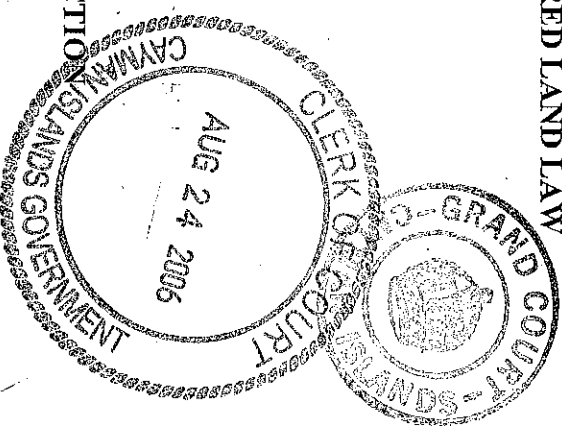


LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a judge of the Grand Court in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands on the _____ day of August 2006 at 9:30am on the hearing ex parte of an application by the Plaintiffs for the following relief:



1. A Declaration that the certain lease (hereinafter the "Lease") of premises situate at and known as Apartment #1, 35 Vibe Lane, West Bay, Grand Cayman (hereinafter the "Leased Premises") made orally and in writing on or about 1st August 2006 and made between the Plaintiff and the Defendant.
2. A Declaration that with the consent of the Defendant and by the Defendant's acceptance of rent from the Plaintiff by reference to the term.
3. An injunction restraining the Defendant from unlawfully and in breach of contract terminating the said Lease whether on the 31st August 2006 or on any other day prior to the termination of the said Lease and not before the 30th September 2006.
4. An injunction restraining the Defendant from forcibly ejecting the Plaintiff from, or preventing the Plaintiffs having access to, the said Leased Premises until the 30th September 2006 or Order of the Court.
5. That the amount of \$750 be reimbursed to the Plaintiffs due to the fact that they have not occupied the premises for the past two and a half weeks if proper access cannot be given to occupy the premises.
6. That the restraining order placed on the Plaintiff by the Defendant at the West Bay Police Station be removed to allow access to the Premises.
7. Further or other relief.
