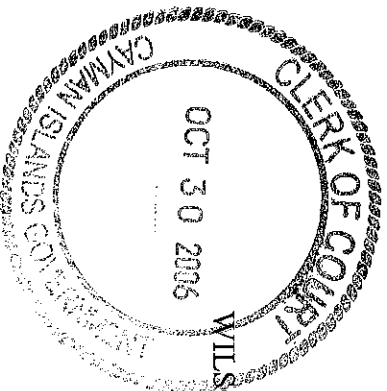

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement with the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

- (1) Quia timet relief namely an order that the Defendant be restrained whether by itself its servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from presenting a petition for the winding up of the Plaintiff based upon the alleged debt referred to in the Statutory Demand dated 6th October 2006 or any part thereof since it is feared that the Defendant will present a petition unless restrained and presentation of a petition would be an abuse of process
- (2) An order for costs to be paid by the Defendant on an indemnity basis if not agreed.
