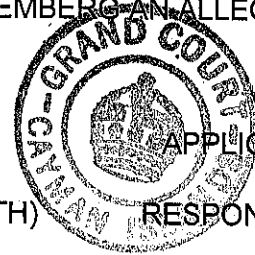
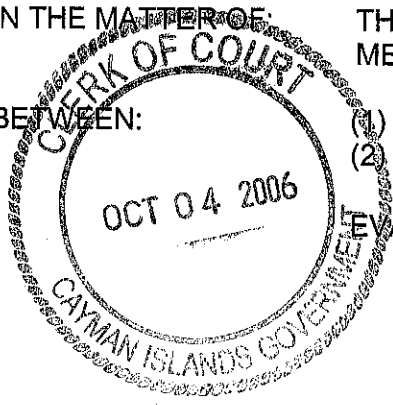

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

1. A declaration that by virtue an Order of the Superior Court of New Jersey, Bergen County, Chancery Division, Probate Part made on 22nd February 2006 in proceedings bearing the Court Docket No: P-460-05 ("the New Jersey Order") the First and Second Applicants are the guardians of the property and / or estate of the said Robert L. Goldemberg situated in the Cayman Islands.
2. A declaration that the First and Second Applicants are authorised and / or empowered by virtue of the New Jersey Order to recover the property and / or estate of the said Robert L. Goldemberg situated in the Cayman Islands and to receive disclosure of all information concerning such property and/or estate.
3. That if at any time there is a disagreement between the First and Second Applicants as co-guardians of the property, the Second Applicant, James A Tassoff's decision will prevail short of judicial review.
4. A declaration that by virtue of the New Jersey Order and the amending Order, the Health care proxy dated 19 December 2004 and the Medical Power of Attorney dated 22 December 2004 are null and void.
5. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court may think fit.

6. That the costs of this Originating Summons may be provided for.


