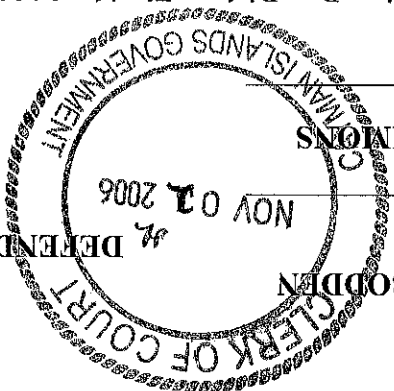
ISSUED this 20th day of October 2006.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at PO Box 301, Broad Street, Bridgetown, Barbados and elsewhere and the Defendant is and was a customer of the Plaintiff.

2. The Defendant is currently indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of the shortfall on the Charge dated 30th March 1998 following the sale of the property registered as Spots, Block 24E, Parcel 137H2 in the principal sum of CI\$30,539.71, together with interest of CI\$19,502.52 and late charges. Interest will continue to accrue on the Defendant's debt at a daily rate of CI\$8.20.

3. The Plaintiff has made a written demand for repayment by letter from its attorneys dated 18th July 2006 but the Defendant has failed to repay the said sum or any part of it.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

1. Payment of the said principal sum of CI\$30,539.71.


2. Interest on the sum of CI\$30,539.71 in the sum of CI\$19,502.52 at a daily rate of CI\$8.20, to the date of issue of these proceedings and continuing thereafter until payment.

3. Fixed costs.

4. Further or other relief.
