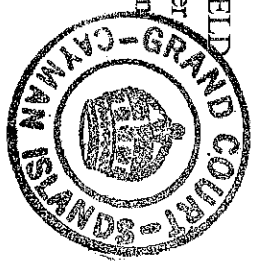
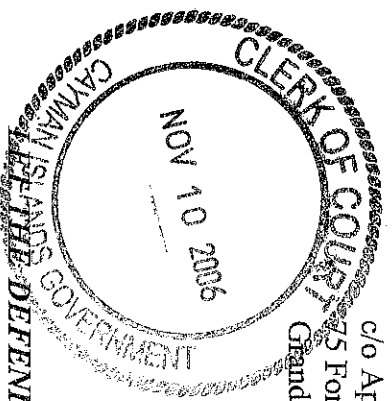


1. That the Defendant/Administrator be ordered to administer the estate of Timothy Emmanuel McField, deceased forthwith.
2. That proper accounting be prepared by the Defendant/Administrator in relation to the said estate within 21 days of the date of this Order.

3. That the encumbrances on the estate be removed within 30 days of the date of this Order.
4. That all properties in the estate be put up for sale with a Real Estate agent and be sold for distribution to the beneficiaries according to Law.
5. Alternatively, that the Defendant be removed as Administrator of the estate and the Plaintiff/Applicant be placed as Administrator of the estate, to administer the estate, in her place.
6. That the costs of this application be provided for.

The Plaintiff/Applicant is the half-sister of the Defendant/Administrator.
The Plaintiff/Applicant and the Defendant/Administrator are two of the five beneficiaries of the estate of Timothy Emmanuel McField, Deceased.

IF THE DEFENDANT DOES NOT ACKNOWLEDGE SERVICE, SUCH JUDGMENT MAY BE GIVEN OR ORDER MADE AGAINST OR IN RELATION TO HER AS THIS HONOURABLE COURT MAY THINK JUST AND EXPEDIENT.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgement of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 Grand Cayman KY1-1106, CAYMAN ISLANDS.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words “sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons).”
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description “*Partner in the firm of* (.....)” after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN**, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description “trading as (.....)” after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Notes on address for service

Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
