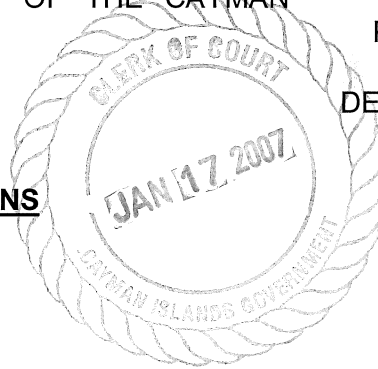

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM


1. The Plaintiff is a bank carrying on business at FirstCaribbean House, 25 Main Street, P.O. Box 1321GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
2. The Defendant is and was at all material times a customer of the Plaintiff.
3. In or around May 1999 the Plaintiff loaned the Defendant the sum of CI\$22,725.00 repayable over 4 years at CI\$539.72 per month with interest accruing at the rate of 14.92% per annum.
4. The Loan was granted to assist the Defendant with the purchase of furniture.
5. The Defendant failed to service the Loan in accordance with the terms on which it was granted.
6. By a letter dated 15 June 2004, the Plaintiff's attorneys made a written demand for repayment of the Loan but the Defendant has failed to repay the whole or any part of the amount outstanding.
7. As at 15 January 2007, the Defendant was indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of the Loan in the amount of CI\$33,814.87 with interest accruing at the rate of 14.92 % per annum or CI\$7.10 per diem.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

- (a) Payment of the principal sum of CI\$33,814.87 outstanding on the Loan;
- (b) Interest pursuant to the Loan from 16 January 2007 accruing at the rate of 14.92% per annum or CI\$7.10 per diem until payment or judgment, or alternatively judicial interest;
- (c) Ad valorem fees of CI\$238.15 and CI\$200 filing fee;

- (d) Costs;
- (e) Further or other relief.
