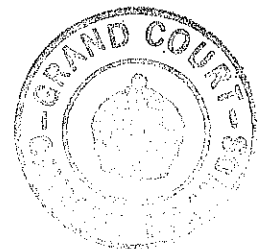
If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and Judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Dental Practitioner who practises dentistry from a Dental Clinic located at George Town, Grand Cayman.

2. The Defendant is an individual who resides at Sunshine Apartments in George Town, Grand Cayman and at the material time he was a patient of the Plaintiff.

3. During the period 5th April, 1995 and 22nd March, 1996 the Defendant had certain dental work completed by the Plaintiff. The Defendant verbally agreed with the Plaintiff to pay for this dental work immediately after the work had been completed. The cumulative cost of the work was CI\$2,100.00.

4. In breach of the said verbal agreement, the Defendant has neglected to pay off the said amount which is still outstanding to the Plaintiff despite repeated demands by the Plaintiff for payment of same.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

- (a) the sum of CI\$2,100.00
- (b) Interest calculated at the prescribed statutory rate
- (c) Costs

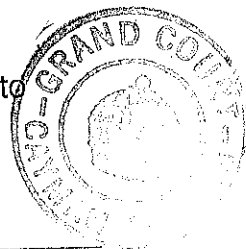
