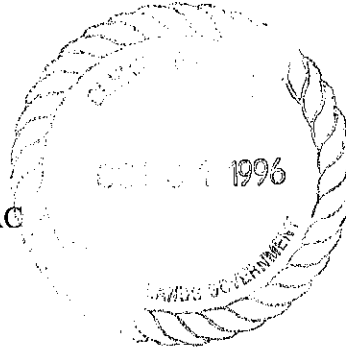

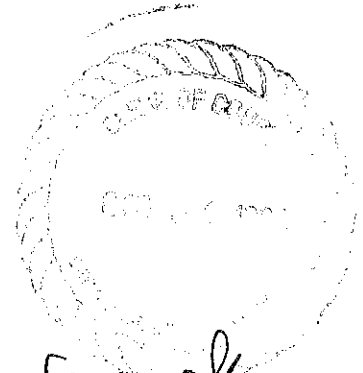
EX PARTE SUMMONS  
(Order 11 Rule 1 Grand Court Rules 1995)

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1996 at 9:30 o'clock in the forenoon, on the hearing of an Application by Plaintiff for orders as follows:-

1. THAT the Intended Plaintiff does have leave to issue a Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim against the Intended Defendant (whose name and address appear on the draft Writ of Summons exhibited to the Affidavit of Diarmad MacFarlane Murray sworn in support hereof) and to serve the said Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim out of the jurisdiction on the said Intended Defendant pursuant to Order 11 Rules 1(d)(iii), and 1(1)(ff) and Order 65 Rule 4 of the Grand Court Rules 1995.
2. THAT the said Intended Defendant does have 21 days after service of the Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim within which to acknowledge service and in default of so doing the Intended Plaintiff does have liberty to proceed with the said action upon proof of service of such process.
3. THAT the Intended Plaintiff does serve a copy of the Order made herein together with such process upon the said Intended Defendant.

4. THAT their be such further and/or order and/or relief as the Court may think fit.
5. That the costs of this application be costs in the cause.
