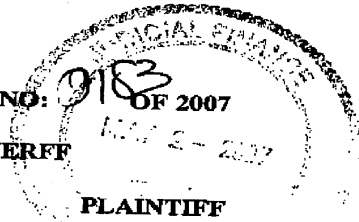
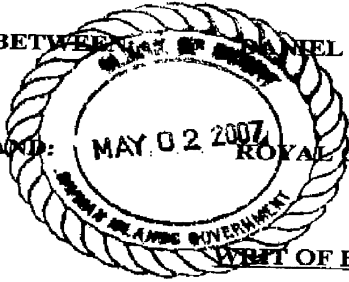

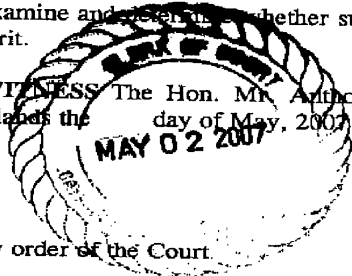
WRIT OF HABEUS CORPUS AD SUBJICIENDUM
