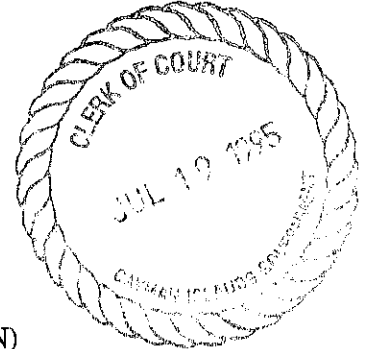

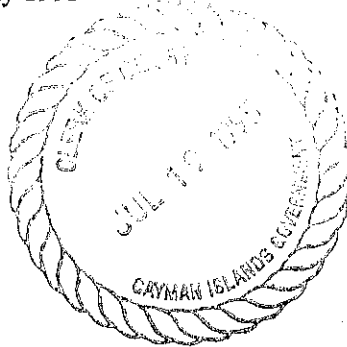
ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANTS attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 26th day of July, 1995, at 9.30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiffs for orders as follows:-

- (1) that the First Defendants be restrained from further acting on behalf of the Second and Third Defendants herein (Gruppo Torras SA and Torras Hostench London Limited) in Cause No. 271 of 1995 or in respect of the subject matter of that action.
- (2) that the First Defendant be restrained from disclosing to the Second and Third Defendants herein any information concerning the assets and affairs of the trust known as the Comfort Trust, the subject of Cause No. 271 of 1995 obtained as a result of their prior representation of the Fourth Defendant herein.
- (3) and that the First Defendants do pay the costs of this action.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 4 days after service of this summons on them counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Court's office.

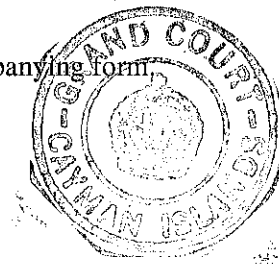
