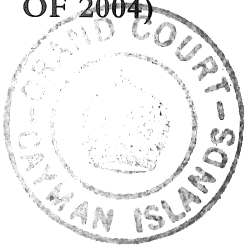

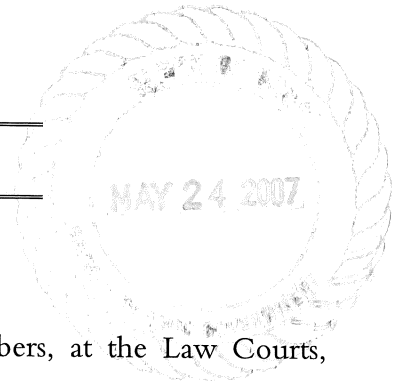

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2007, at 9:30 am, on the hearing of an application by the First to Thirteenth Defendants in Cause No. 350 of 2004 (the "Applicants") for an order under section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision) as follows:

1. That this Honourable Court do give such directions regarding the disclosure of confidential information pursuant to paragraphs 1 to 3 of the Order of this Honourable Court dated 28th of February 2007 in Cause No. 350 of 2004 as may be deemed fit and proper, including but not limited to directions pursuant to section 4(3) of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision) that:
 - (a) the Applicants shall if so requested permit inspection and copying of the files listed under Schedule 1, Part 3 of the Combined List of Documents of the First to Thirteenth Defendants by the Plaintiffs and/or the Fourteenth and/or Fifteenth Defendants in Cause No. 350 of 2004 (the Plaintiffs and the Fourteenth and Fifteenth Defendants hereinafter referred to as the "Parties");

- (b) in the event any confidential information is disclosed and/or produced to the Parties pursuant to paragraph 1(a) herein, they and their legal advisers will be bound by the provisions of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision) in relation to that information;
- (c) in the event any confidential information is disclosed and/or produced to the Parties and it comes to the attention of the Defendants:
 - (i) the Defendants will, within 48 hours, inform the Parties and request the return of all copies of the documents which contain such confidential information, which the Parties shall return within 48 hours; and
 - (ii) upon receipt of such copy documents, the Defendants, will, if appropriate, promptly redact the confidential information and return the redacted copy documents to the Parties;
- (d) in the event any confidential information is disclosed and/or produced to the Parties and it comes to their attention:
 - (i) the Parties will, within 48 hours inform the Defendants and return all of their copies of the documents which contain such confidential information;
 - (ii) upon receipt of such copy documents, the Defendants will, if appropriate, promptly redact the confidential information and return the redacted copy documents to the Parties; and
- (e) in the event that the Parties object to the redaction of any part of the Defendants' discovery, the parties shall have liberty to apply for specific directions respecting the information sought to be redacted.

2. That such further or other orders as may be deemed fit and proper be made, including as to costs.
