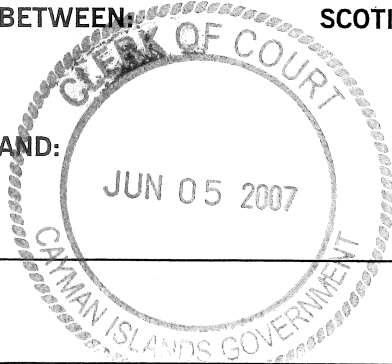



2. **THAT** the Defendant and, upon service of this Order upon such person, any other person(s) occupying the Property do, within 28 days of service of this Order, vacate the Property and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the Property.
3. **THAT** this Honourable Court do give directions with regard to the price for the sale of the Property.
4. **Such** further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days of this Summons on each of them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman KY1-1106, Cayman Islands.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
