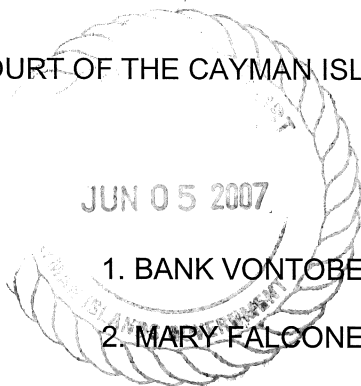

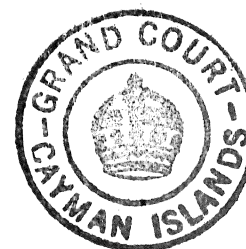

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



TO: THE CHIEF IMMIGRATION OFFICER

LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, the Applicants seek the following declarations:

1. That, pending the outcome of the application for permanent residence made by the husband of the Second Applicant ("the permanent residence application") under section 29 of the Immigration Law (2006 Revision) ("the Law") the Second Applicant is entitled to work by operation of law under section 50(6) of the Law;
2. That, in the event that the permanent residence application is declined, the Second Applicant will be entitled to a final, one year non-renewable work permit under section 50(9) of the Law;
3. Such further or other relief as this honourable Court thinks fit

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
