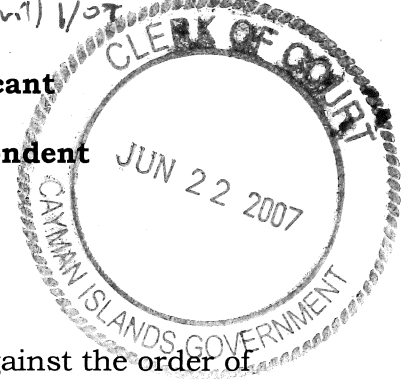
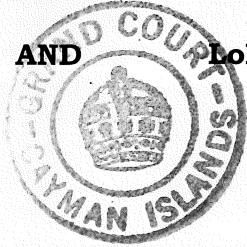

NOTICE OF APPEAL

TAKE NOTICE that I, John Wesley McLaughlin intend to appeal against the order of the summary Court made on the 8th June 2007.

The grounds of appeal are as follows-

That the Magistrate erred in fact and in law in finding that the applicant is liable to pay the sum of CI\$150 per month in maintenance to the respondent.

The Magistrate was wrong in finding that the Applicant had left the respondent and not vice versa.

That the Magistrate's award of a 'nominal' sum of CI\$150 per month was not nominal, equitable or just in the circumstances of the case.
