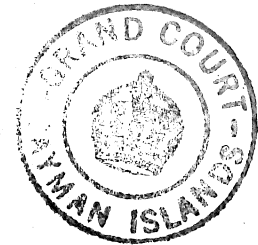

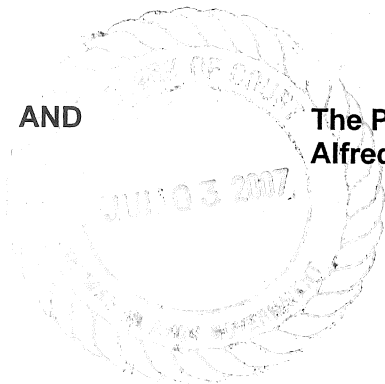

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the _____ day of _____ 2007, at _____ o'clock, on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff that;

1. the personal representatives of the Estate of Alfred Lawrence Powell (deceased) ("the Estate"), namely, Alfred McClean and Randy McClean ("Personal Representatives") of PO Box 11097 APO East End, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, be replaced by other suitable persons to be appointed at the discretion of this Honourable Court;
2. all Registered Land transfers to date effecting the Estate which have been approved and sanctioned by the Personal Representatives of the Estate be hereby revoked and the Land Register rectified accordingly;
3. the Plaintiffs in these proceedings be duly recognised and declared as being the majority of the lawful children of the Estate and as such, *bona fide* beneficiaries' of the said Estate in accordance with the Succession Law (2006 Revision);
4. an Inhibition be placed on the Land Registry by order of the Court in relation to the Estate until further order;
5. Costs of this application to be in the Cause.

The grounds for the above requested applications are that the Personal Representatives of the Estate provided factually incorrect information by way of sworn affidavit to the Supervisor of the Civil Registry, knowing that the information was incorrect, which resulted in the exclusion of the majority of lawful children as beneficiaries of the Estate, namely Meldine Powell, Ventris Powell, Astor Powell, Annistine Powell Seymour, Arlain Powell Connolly, Leroy Powell and Rolylin Powell, the Plaintiffs.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
