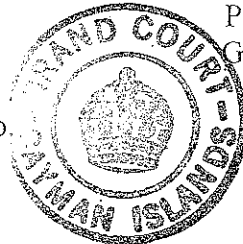

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.


STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff claims CI\$26,164.06 from the Defendants for overseas medical expenses.
2. On the 30th April 1997 the Defendants signed a promissory note agreeing to repay the Cayman Islands Government for all expenses paid for Sophia N. Benjamin-Snape to be treated at the Baptist Hospital of Miami on or around the 30th April 1997.
3. Sophia N. Benjamin-Snape overseas medical expenses amounted to CI\$26,164.06.
4. The Defendants signed a promissory note agreeing to pay CI\$250.00 per month.
5. The Cayman Islands Health Services Authority and the Debt Recovery Unit communicated with the Defendant on numerous occasions, requesting payment.
6. No payment has been made towards this debt and the balance of CI\$26,164.06, still remains unpaid.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The sum of CI\$26,164.06.
2. Interest at the statutory rate of 3%
3. Process Server's fee
3. Fixed cost of CI\$500.00, alternatively costs to be assessed.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff.
