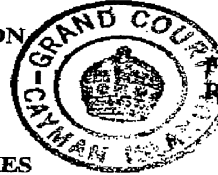

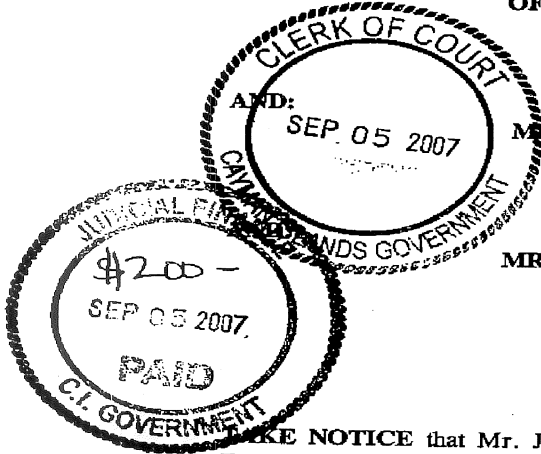

NOTICE OF MOTION


TAKE NOTICE that Mr. Justice _____ sitting at the Law Courts, George Town, on the _____ day of _____, 20 at _____ o'clock or so soon thereafter as Counsel can be heard on behalf of Joint Provisional Liquidators of Island Supply Company Limited will be moved by Counsel for the Joint Provisional Liquidators of Island Supply Company Limited for an order pursuant to Part I of GCR Order 52 that Mr. Peter Dutton and Mr. Fraser Hughes be committed to prison on the grounds that the Respondents have breached the Order made by this Court on 4th September 2007 whereby the Respondents are required to allow the duly appointed Joint Provisional Liquidators of Island Supply Company Limited "to do any acts or things considered by them to be necessary or desirable in connection with the getting in and preservation of assets and documents of the Company pending the hearing of the Petitioner's winding up petition".

And for an order that the Respondents to pay the costs of this application.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds of this application are that on or around 10:45 a.m. on the 5th September 2007 Mr. Peter Dutton, on the instructions of his attorney Mr. Fraser Hughes, refused access to the offices, staff, accounts and documents of Island Supply Company Limited contrary to the Order of the Grand Court dated 4th September 2007 and they did further obstruct the duly appointed Joint Provisional Liquidators from carry out their duties pursuant to that same order.
