

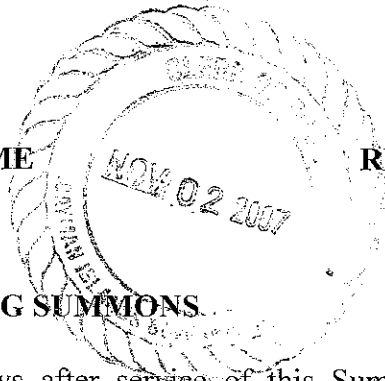

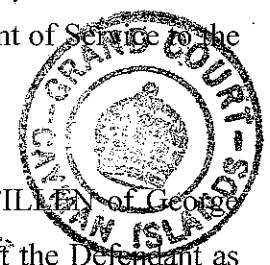

ORIGNATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 295, George Town, Grand Cayman.



By this Summons, which is issued on the application of AMY KILFILLEN of George Town, Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff herein, seeks an injunction against the Defendant as follows:

1. That the Respondent do not use or threaten to use violent on the Applicant.
2. That the Respondent is restrained from going to the Applicant's residence and workplace.
3. That the Respondent is restrained from doing any act by himself, his servants or agents calculated to harass or to molest the Applicant.
4. That this Order shall remain in effect from 28 days from the date hereof and that the matter be brought back before the Court on
5. That this Order shall take effect upon service upon the Respondent and that such service do take place forthwith with the assistance of the Royal Cayman Islands Police.

6. That any member of the Police Service shall have power by section 8 of the Law to charge and arrest the Respondent forthwith if he fails to comply with or breach this Order AND bring him immediately before the Court.
7. The Respondent must take note that failure to obey this Order will be a contempt of Court and will result in further charges and/or imprisonment.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
