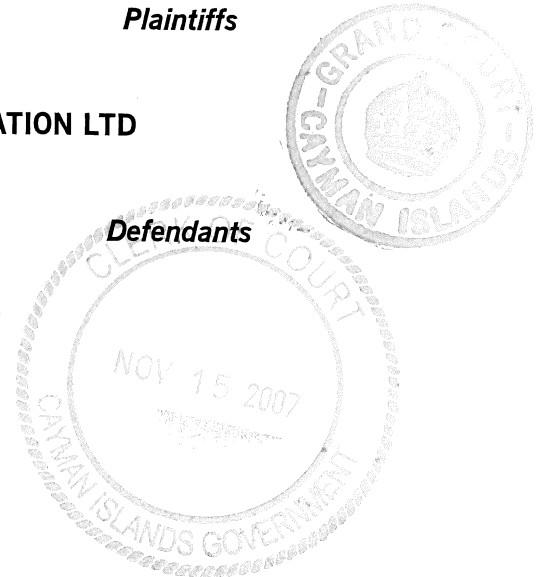

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

The Plaintiffs seek specific performance of contractual undertakings given by the Defendants by letter dated 14 February 2005 in relation to shares in Cayman National Corporation Limited ("CNC") acquired by the First Defendant in consideration for the sale to CNC of its business by agreement dated 31 December 2004 and relief consequent to the breach, and threatened breach of those undertakings by the Defendants

### AND THE PLAINTIFFS claim:

1. An injunction to restrain the Defendants from dealing with or otherwise disposing of the shares in CNC without giving the Plaintiffs seven days advance notice of any intended disposition;
2. An injunction to restrain the Defendants from dealing with or otherwise disposing of the proceeds of the sale of shares in CNC without giving the Plaintiffs seven days advance notice of any intended disposition;
3. Such tracing and/or discovery and/or injunctive and/or other equitable or other relief as this Honourable Court deems fit;
4. Further and/or alternatively damages for breach of the undertakings given by the Defendants by letter dated 14 February 2005;
5. Costs.
