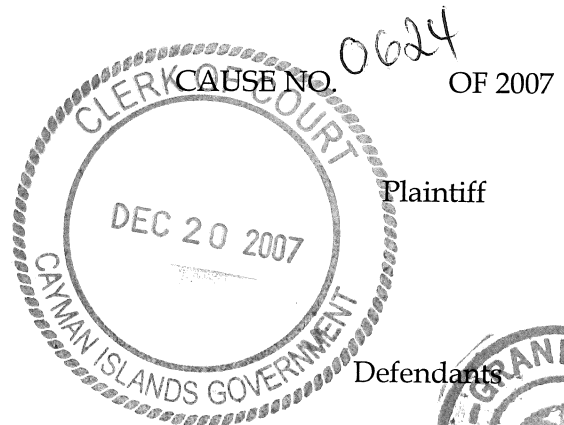


IN THE GRAND COURT OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

BETWEEN: **BANK OF CHINA**

AND: (1) **CB LIMITED**

(2) **CENTURY LIMITED**



ORIGINATING SUMMONS

To: CB Limited and Century Limited, both c/o Maples and Calder, PO Box 309, Uglan House, South Church Street, KY1-1104, Grand Cayman, the persons against whom the Charging Orders hereinafter mentioned were obtained

LET the Defendants, within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495 G, George Town, Grand Cayman

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, Bank of China, 410 Madison Avenue, New York, NY 10017, a judgment creditor entitled to the benefit of the Charging Orders, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendants:

1. An order that the properties known as West Bay Beach South, Block 12D, Parcels 25H15, 40H18 and 40H30, which properties ("the Charged Properties") stand charged with payment to the Plaintiff of a sum of US\$2,000,000 and interest there, the amount due under a Default Judgment dated 23 December 2002, pursuant to a Charging Orders Nisi dated 1 April 2003, may be sold and that the money to arise by such sale be applied in discharge of what shall be due to the Plaintiff under the said Charging Orders and for its costs of this action, and any surplus be paid to the Defendants.

2. An Order that, pending such sale, Christopher D Johnson, or some other fit and proper person, be appointed Receiver by way of equitable execution of the rents, profits and money receivable in respect of the Charged Properties (including any such rents, profits and money received by the Defendants' Cayman Islands' agents prior to the date of such appointment and retained by them as at that date) upon such terms as to remuneration and otherwise as that Plaintiff and the Receiver may agree and the Court approve.
3. Further or other relief.
4. Costs.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Originating Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN**, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on his behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
