of the Estate of the said Terrents Solomon aka Terrants Solomon, Deceased, as stipulated  
in the Letters of Administration granted to her in the said Estate dated 18th August, 2005.

2 That this Honourable Court makes a Declaration as to the entitlement of the Plaintiff  
from the Estate of the said Terrents Solomon aka Terrants Solomon, Deceased.

3 That the Defendants do provide any such entitlement Declared under paragraph 2  
above, to the Plaintiff.

4 That in the meantime a restriction be placed on the title to the property located at  
**Registration Section: Bodden Town Block 44B Parcel 3, restricting all dealing**  
**relating to same**, which property previously formed an asset of the Estate of the said  
Terrents Solomon aka Terrants Solomon, Deceased, but which the First Defendant, as  
Administrator of the said Estate, unlawfully transferred into her sole name.

5 Such further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court shall deem appropriate.

**AND LET THE DEFENDANTS** within 14 days after the service of this summons on her counting the day of service return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office.
