
By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Shawnee L. Ebanks of 35 Vibes lane Apt No. 1 Forest Haven, George Town Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff claim against the Defendant seeking relief as follows:

1. A Declaration that the agreement made 8th day of August 2007 between the Plaintiff and Defendant is a binding agreement between the Parties.
2. That in accordance section B of the said agreement the Defendant be ordered to transfer Block 22E Parcel 260H1 into the sole name of the Plaintiff and the Plaintiff will transfer Block 23C Parcel 179 into the sole name of the Defendant.
3. That the Defendant be ordered to hand over the executed transfer forms and all other documents signed between the Parties.
4. Further or in the alternative if the Defendant refuses to hand over the said documents and/or refuses to sign the required transfer forms that the Clerk of the Court or such other officer assigned be required to execute the said documents on the Defendant's behalf.
5. An injunction restraining the Defendant or anyone acting on his behalf from interfering with the Plaintiff possession and or enjoyment of the said

premises located at Apt No. 1 Forest Haven, George Town Grand Cayman.

6. That the Defendant pays the cost of these proceedings.
7. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court deems just.

OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of acknowledgement of service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an acknowledgement of service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgement of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledgement of service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is used as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
