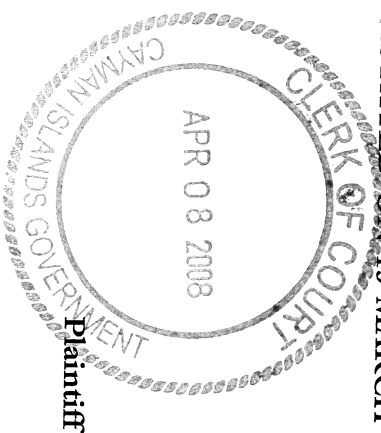



LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of 2008 at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following relief:

1. That Mr. Jens Peter Rønning of Braathen Eiendom, Oslo, Norway be appointed Guardian of Mr. Egil Arne Braathen (“**Mr. Braathen**”) pursuant to section 14 of the *Grand Court Law (2006 Revision)* for the sole purpose of representing Mr. Braathen’s interests in intended proceedings against the Trustee of the EB and PB Trusts in respect of alleged breaches of trust and in place of Carlos de Serpa Pimentel appointed as Mr. Braathen’s Guardian in Cause No. 329 of 2006 to represent Mr. Braathen’s interests in Cause No. 103 of 2006.
2. That, in the circumstances, the Court dispense with service of this Ex parte Originating Summons and supporting documentation on the Defendant.
3. That provision be made for the costs of this application.
4. Any other Order that this Honourable Court deems appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 28 days after service of this summons on them counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts office.
