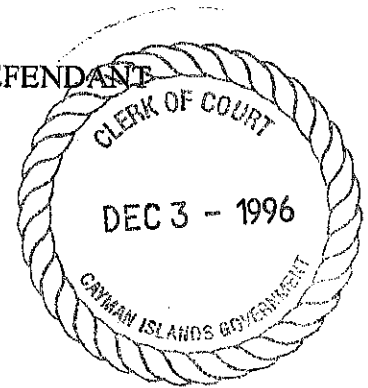

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

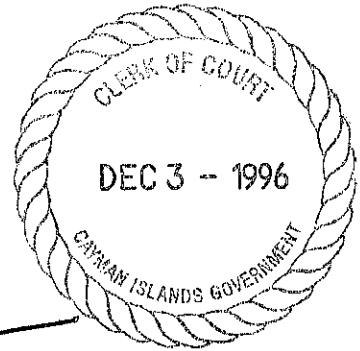

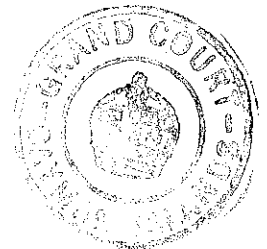
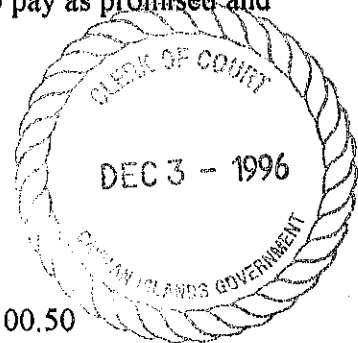
STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff is and was at all material times a local Company which has a licence to sell ready mixed concrete.
2. The defendant is and was at all material times a Building Contractor who ran a credit account with the plaintiff.
3. On the 16th day of March, 1996 the defendant obtained 10.5 yards of ready mixed concrete, valued at \$1,233.00 from the plaintiff on credit to work on the New Cracked Conch building in West Bay.
4. On the 27th March, 1996 the defendant obtained another 7 yards of ready mixed concrete valued at \$754.00 and on the 30th day of April, 1996 he obtained another 3 yards valued at \$313.50 making a total of **\$2,300.50** due and owing.
5. The defendant promised the plaintiff that he would pay the full amount due and owing for the concrete between May and June when he would receive a cheque from the owner of the building but the defendant failed to pay as promised and several demands made for payment have been futile.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims:-

1. The amount due
2. Costs to be taxed or agreed.
3. Interest

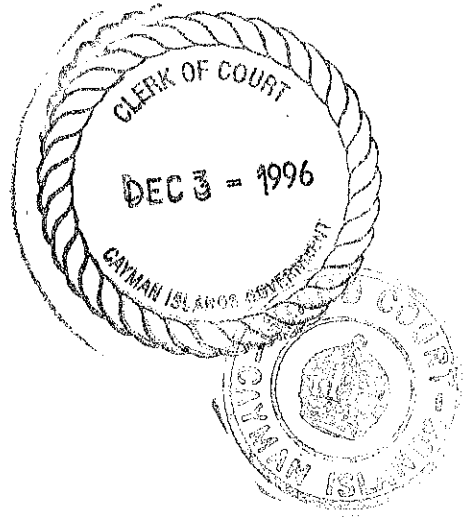
