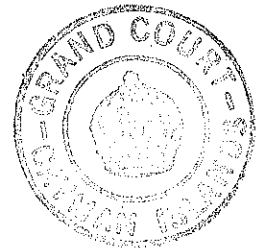

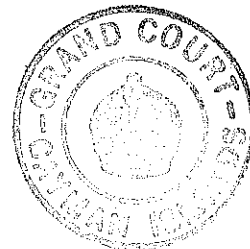
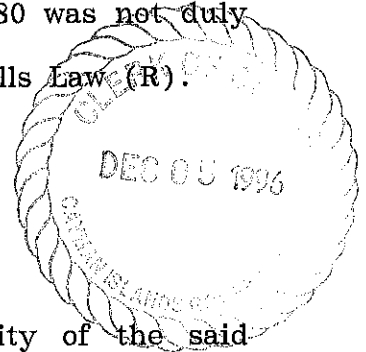


STATEMENT OF CLAIM


1. The Plaintiffs are the lawful sons and two of the persons entitled to share in the estate of Herbert Leslie Wilson late of George Town, Grand Cayman who died on the 9th day of April, 1982 intestate.
2. On or about the 4th day of August, 1992, an application for a Grant of Probate of an alleged Will of the said deceased dated the 5th day of September, 1980 was filed in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands by the First Defendant as an Executor named therein.
3. The alleged Will dated the 5th day of September, 1980 was not duly executed in accordance with the provisions of the Wills Law (R).

AND THE PLAINTIFFS claim:

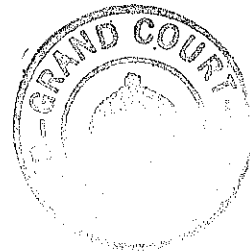
1. That the Court shall pronounce against the validity of the said alleged Will dated the 5th day of September, 1980.

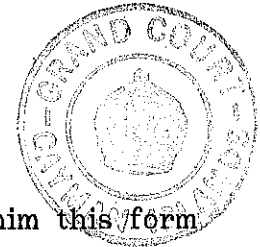

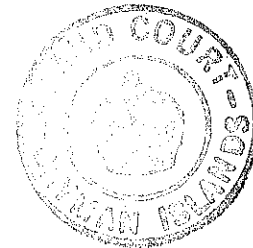
