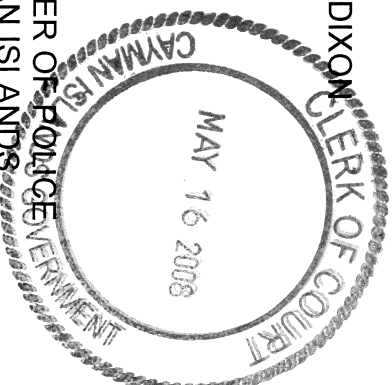

Relief Sought

1. The immediate unconditional release of the Plaintiff from custody and/or detention.
2. An immediate Writ of Habeas Corpus Ad Subjiciendum be issued directed to the Commissioner of Police for the Cayman Islands that the body of RUDOLPH DIXON be immediately brought before the Court at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands together with the day and cause of their being taken and detained, that the Court may examine and determine whether such cause is legal;
2. Alternatively a Direction by the Court that an application be made by the Plaintiff by Originating Motion that a Writ of *Habeas Corpus Ad Subjiciendum* be to the Court at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands together with the day and cause of him being taken and detained, that the Court may examine and determine whether such cause is legal.
3. An Order that the Defendant do disclose and discover to the Plaintiff's Attorney copies of all documents in the possession or control of the Defendant relevant to the Plaintiff relating to the day and cause as to why the Plaintiff is detained in custody.



GROUNDNS ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT

The Plaintiff relies on the following grounds:

1. That the custody and detention of the Plaintiff is unlawful.
2. That the custody and detention of the Plaintiff is a breach of their human right to liberty and their right to freedom from abuse and degrading treatment by other prisoners and prison staff pending any future prosecution;

3. Alternatively, that even if the custody and detention of the Plaintiff is lawful that he ought in the interests of justice to be permitted to be discharged from prison pending the trial (if any) of the offences with which he is being investigated for or may stand charged either subject to no conditions or on such conditions as the Court thinks fit;
