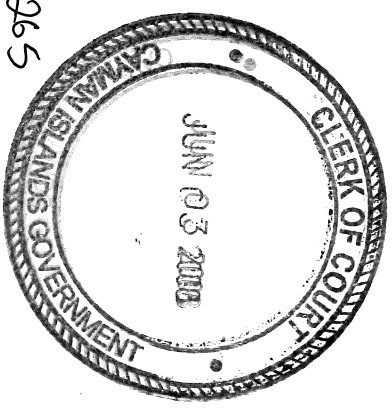

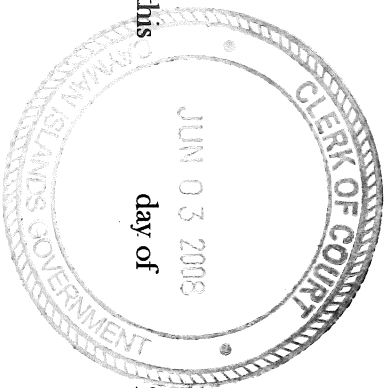
WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within (14 days) after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. 495 G.T., George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

INDORSMENT OF WRIT

THE PLAINTIFF'S CLAIM IS:

- (a) As a customer of the said Fosters Food Fair ("the premises"), Dorcy Drive George Town, Grand Cayman who while shopping at the said supermarket was hit in the back by a trolley and sustained injury to her neck and back for breach of duty on the part of the Defendant as owner and occupier of the premises on the relevant date for damages for negligence for failing to ensure that the premises was safe and for failing to take reasonable care to make the premises as safe as reasonable care and skill could have made them.
- (b) For damages for personal injury and consequential loss and/or damages suffered by the said Tricia Hopkins on the 4th day of June 2005 when whilst shopping at the food store she was hit from behind with a trolley which was owned by the Defendant and sustained injury.
- (e) For the costs of this action.

Acknowledgment of Service (Rule.11)

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE

***IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU GIVE HIM
THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY***

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Defendant and his attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 G.T., George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgment of Service must be filed at court and served on the attorney for the Plaintiff (or on the Plaintiff if acting in person) within fourteen days service of the Writ of Summons.
4. A Defendant who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Plaintiff (or on the Plaintiff if acting in person within fourteen days after service of the Writ of Summons.
5. In case of Writ of Summons is served outside the Cayman Islands the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgment of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.

- b) by notice of such intention lodged in the Registry within fourteen days of the service of this Writ of Summons, or
