THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you as a named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P. O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

6. Whilst speaking to Mr. Rudolph Gordon in the said Church office, the Defendant stated to Mr. Gordon that her intention was "to take us down" or some statement to the same effect, meaning the Plaintiff and Mrs. Peguero.
7. Mr. Rudolph Gordon was able to persuade the Defendant to calm down and to speak with the Plaintiff and Mrs. Peguero in his presence after the Church Service around 12:00PM. The Plaintiff consented to speak to the Defendant; however Mrs. Peguero was refusing to speak with the Defendant but did so, so as to avoid a breach of the peace, by the Defendant.
8. During the said meeting between the Plaintiff, the Defendant, Mrs. Peguero, and Mr. Gordon, the Defendant verbally abused her mother Mrs. Peguero. The Defendant also stated that the Plaintiff, sometime in the 1980 "unlawfully and improperly touchier her".
9. The Defendant has for some years since the Plaintiff's said marriage to the Defendants mother Mrs. Peguero, has been telling other persons as well as her friends that the Plaintiff "improperly touched her".
10. The Defendant's said words spoken and published to the Plaintiff, Mr. Gordon. Mrs. Peguero, other people and the Defendant's friends of and concerning the Plaintiff are false and malicious.
11. The said words in their natural and ordinary meaning meant and were understood to mean that the Plaintiff was guilty of improper conduct and is of immoral character.
12. The said words were calculated to disparage the Plaintiff in his professions as a Businessman and a Pastor.
13. In Consequence of the Said words the Plaintiff has been greatly injured in his Credit and his professions as a Businessman and a Pastor and has been brought into public scandal ridicule and contempt.
14. The Defendant threatens and intends, unless restrained by this Honourable Court, to continue and to repeat the said false and malicious words above complained of.

And The Plaintiff Claims:-

1. An injunction to restrain the Defendant by herself her Servants agents friends or otherwise howsoever from repeating the said words complained of and from interfering with the Plaintiff at his home, place of Business and or his Church, the Frank Sound Church of God.
2. Damages
3. Such further or other Relief as the Court deem proper.
