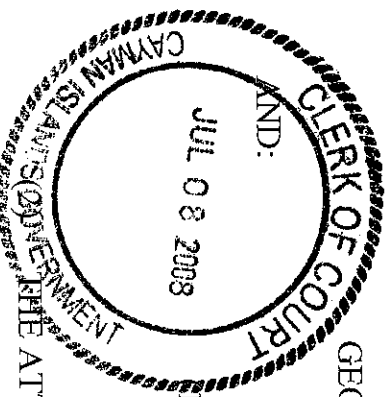

upon the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following directions and/or
orders, namely: -

- (1) that this application and the Plaintiff's proposed application by Originating
Summons for a variation of trusts shall not unless otherwise directed by this Court
be entered in the Court's Register of Writs and other Originating Process;
- (2) that the Court file in relation to this matter and the Plaintiff's proposed application
for a variation of trusts be closed and not open to inspection by any party or person
other than the Plaintiff except with the prior leave of the Court;

- (3) that the Settlement shall hereafter be referred to on the face of all Court documents as the "Continuity II Trust" and that the beneficiaries of the Settlement shall hereafter be referred to on the face of the Court documents collectively as the "beneficiaries of the Continuity II Trust" and individually by the initials of their first, middle (if applicable) and last names;
- (4) that Counsel for the Plaintiff file in a sealed envelope a detailed memorandum setting out full identifying details of the parties to these proceedings which shall be kept sealed on the Court file;
- (6) such further or other directions or orders as the Court may think fit;
- (7) that the costs of and occasioned by this application be raised and paid by the First Defendant out of the assets of the Continuity II Trust.
