

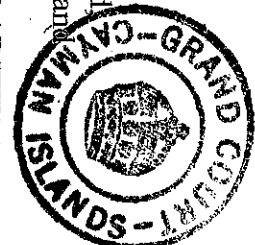
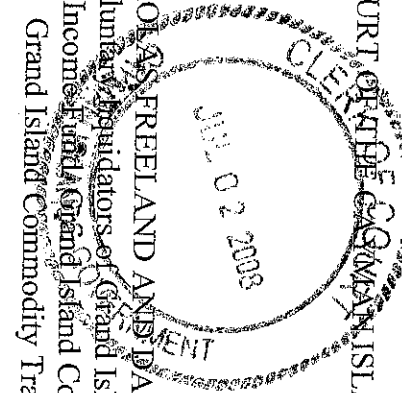


1. The Defendants do account to the Plaintiffs for any and all sums received by the Defendants from the Plaintiffs, directly or indirectly;

3. An account of all sums received by the Defendants representing income on proceeds of such sums and all such assets or any part thereof; and,
4. Interest by way of equitable relief at a commercial rate on all sums found due to the Plaintiffs.
5. Further or other relief.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.
