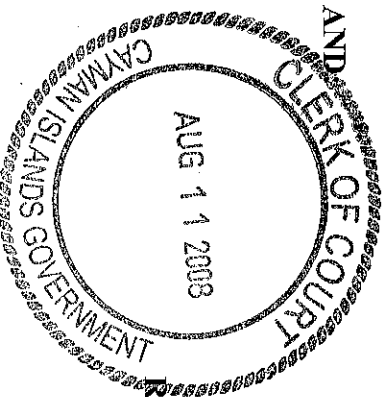

WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: Rodney Dexter Miller, P.O. Box 595, Grand Cayman KY1-1502, and Suzanne Miller, P.O. Box 595, Grand Cayman KY1-1502.

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of the Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 15th day of August 2008 .

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.


INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff claims from the Defendant the sum of CI\$25,840.00 pursuant to a Tenancy Agreement for the rental of a dwelling house on property known as 1000 Queen's Highway, East End, Grand Cayman, Registration Section East End, Block 65A, Parcel 49.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. the sum of CI\$25,840.00;
2. Interest on the sum of CI\$25,840.00 pursuant to section 34 of the *Judicature Law (2007 Revision)* at the statutory rate of 7 ¼ % as follows:
3.
 - i) from the 10th day of July 2008 to the date hereof, namely, 15 August 2008, in the sum of CI\$189.81; and
 - ii) from the date hereof to the date of judgment and thereafter to the date of payment of the said judgment sum at the said statutory rate per annum (ie. CI\$5.13 per day);
 - iii) interest on such sum as is awarded to the Plaintiff at such other rate and for such other period as this Honourable Court may find just pursuant to the Judicature Law (2007 Revision) and the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules 2006 or pursuant to the inherent jurisdiction of the Court.
4. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$26,029.81 (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the appropriate "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of ()" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as ()" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
