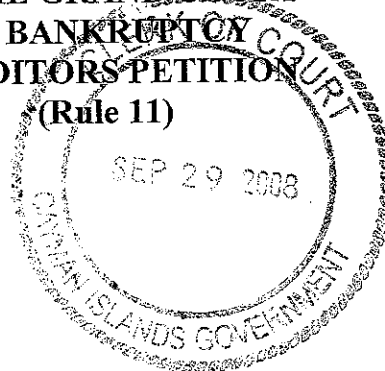

To the Grand Court

The petition of Mary Virginia Thompson of George Town, Grand Cayman sheweth:

1. That Steve Reid of 58 Eclipse Drive, George Town, Grand Cayman is indebted to your petitioner in the sum of US\$ 55,035.40 pursuant to the Default Judgment in Grand Court Cause No. 618 of 2007 filed on 27 February 2008.
2. That your petitioner doth not, nor doth any person or persons on her behalf, hold any security on the said Steve Reid's estate, or on any part thereof, for the payment of the said sum. Save as to note that two cheques totaling US\$ 12,000.00 expressed to be on terms unacceptable to me were provided by the Debtor. As those terms were not accepted, those cheques have not been deposited.
3. That the said Steve Reid has committed an act of bankruptcy within six months before the presentation of this petition.
4. That the act of bankruptcy committed by him was that he did not within seven days after service of a bankruptcy notice in writing pay the outstanding amount per s14(h) of the Bankruptcy Law (1997 Revision).

Your petitioner therefore prays that, on proof of the requisites in that behalf, on the hearing of this petition, the said Steve Reid may be adjudicated a bankrupt.
